

**FAMILY ITHYCERIDAE**  
**(New York weevil)**

This family includes only one species. The adults feed on the tender shoots and buds of various hardwoods and occasionally on some cultivated fruit trees. The larvae feed on the roots of the host plants.

Sanborne (1981) studied the larval and adult morphologies as well as the biology of the species.
