

FAMILY NOSODENDRIDAE
(Wounded-tree beetles)

This small family contains only one genus with about 50 species of which two are recorded for Canada. According to Lawrence (1982a), *Nosodendron* species occur in most forested areas of the world where they inhabit slime fluxes and rancid tree wounds, probably feeding on bacteria, fungi and products of fermentation.

The New World species of the family are well-known taxonomically thanks to the revision of Reichardt (1976).
